## **Meeting Notes**

- The Fan Advisory Board enquired about the status of front-of-shirt sponsorship moving forward due to the new rules around betting partners. With 11 Premier League clubs currently in partnership with a betting company, Francesco Calvo advised that this is a highly competitive market and remains a top priority.
- FAB advised their website was ready to launch and would go live shortly.
- Each FAB Extended Network group provided an update on their respective group's progress.
- The club committed to providing a date for the next round of discussions with the Fan Engagement group.
- A date will be put in the diary for the first meeting of the Ticketing Group.
- An update from FAB on meetings currently ongoing with the Premier League, Level Playing Field and DSA for the disability group was shared.
- It was agreed that the FAB and the football club would work collaboratively to appoint the additional members required for each of the extended network groups.
- In response to feedback provided by the FAB both before and during the meeting, the Club confirmed that ticketing issues remains an active ongoing priority to support those fans encountering problems entering the ground.
- The advert for the Junior FAB is now live and the club invited the FAB to share. The FAB confirmed it was pleased to do so.
